There will be 2 awards of \$500 each

1. An applicant must be either:

An active volunteer firefighter or their daughter, son, adopted child, guardian child, grandchild and/or stepchild residing within the Township of Brookhaven.

A disabled volunteer firefighter or their daughter, son, adopted child, guardian child, grandchild and/or stepchild residing within the Township of Brookhaven.

A daughter, son, adopted child, guardian child, grandchild and/or stepchild of a deceased volunteer firefighter residing within the Town of Brookhaven.


2. An applicant must meet the following criteria:

Have an 85 grade point average throughout high school.

Complete a school activity sheet to be signed by your Guidance Counselor.

Demonstration of written expression in the form of an essay of approximately 500 words, "Future Goals I wish to attain through Education and Volunteerism".

3. Application must be:

Signed by the Volunteer Firefighter / parent or guardian

Signed by a Department Fire Chief

Where applicable, signed by an adult coordinator and a school guidance counselor

Application must be postmarked by May1; and mailed to the address listed at the end of this application

Announcement to the winners will be made by mail to all Brookhaven Township Fire Departments.


The winners will be notified and the award ceremony will be at the August Regular Meeting

4. Awards:

There are no restrictions on a student's choice of college or university




